## Silver

### Cupcake Recipe: Serves 10

100g butter or margarine  
100g caster sugar  
2 free-range eggs, lightly beaten  
1 tsp vanilla extract  
100g self-raising flour  
2 tbsp milk

### For the buttercream icing

150g butter, softened  
2 tbsp milk  
200g icing sugar



### Gingerbread Recipe: Serves 10

350g plain flour  
1 tsp bicarbonate of soda  
2 tsp ground ginger  
1 tsp ground cinnamon  
120g butter  
180g light soft brown sugar  
1 free-range eggs  
4 tbsp golden syrup
