Children need to learn how to behave well and interact positively with one another, just as they need to learn how to read and write, and just like with the academic subjects, some children find this easier than others. We make sure that we discuss poor behaviour choices with children (and their parents where needed), and use appropriate sanctions to enable the child to learn from the experience. Also, I am sure you totally understand that we are unable to discuss children's private information with anyone other than their own family and so we can't always go into too much detail. This is not to hide information from others, it is purely to protect and look after the children in our classes. If you have any queries or concerns, please come and speak to me directly. I am always available before and after school and am happy to chat!
