Things to know:

Enquiry Question of the week

Q: How can you program the Bee-Bot to go in different directions?

A: You can program the Bee-Bot by pressing its buttons. Press forward to make it go straight, backwards to make it go back, left to make it turn left and right to make it turn right. Each button press is one step. When you're ready, press Go and the Bee-Bot will follow your instructions in order.
