Things to know for next week:

- ★ A polite reminder that reading records and reading books should be in school every day. We are trying to read as much as possible with the children, and ensure that they have an appropriate level of reading book, but can only do that if their books and records are in. The children also use their records to log into their Chromebooks for Computing, which they have to do at least once a week. We appreciate it's difficult to remember every day, but please try to remember to keep them in their school bags when possible. Thank you in advance.

Enquiry Question of the week

What is a day in the life of a Chinese student like and how does it compare to your school day?

There are lots of similarities and differences to our school days. Some similarities are: wearing uniforms, learning maths and literacy skills, as well as a range of foundation lessons. Some differences are: Chinese school days are usually longer, their breaks are guided movement rather than free time, and they do homework in their lunch breaks.

- Practise addition and subtraction skills on Numbots at least 3 times a week.

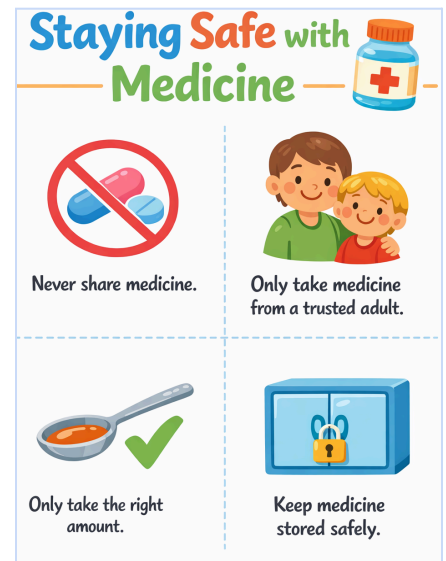
"Dip" into these tasks:

Gold
