

## Nursery Peek at the Week

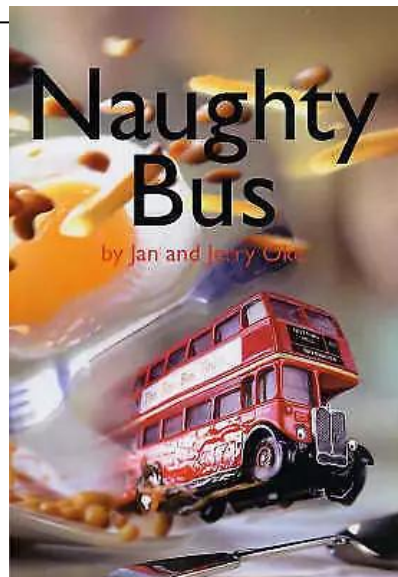
### Weekly News

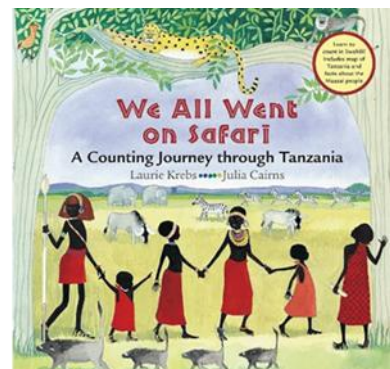
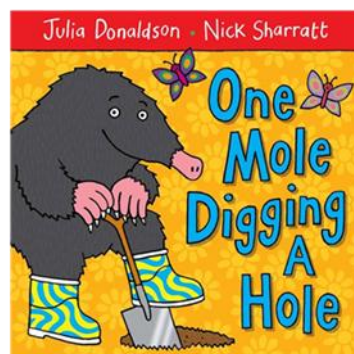
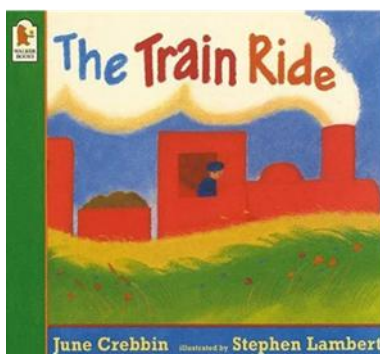

**3-a-day Stories:** The children have learnt our last 3 a day stories really well. These are our new 3 a day stories for this half term:



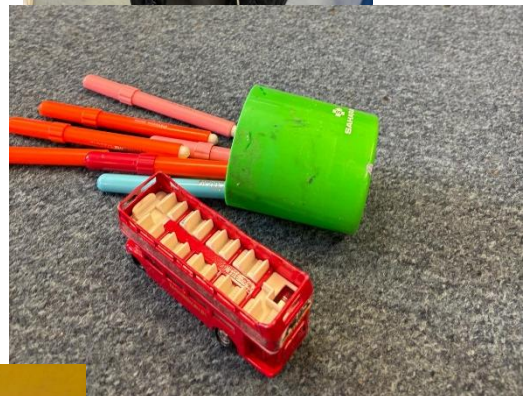
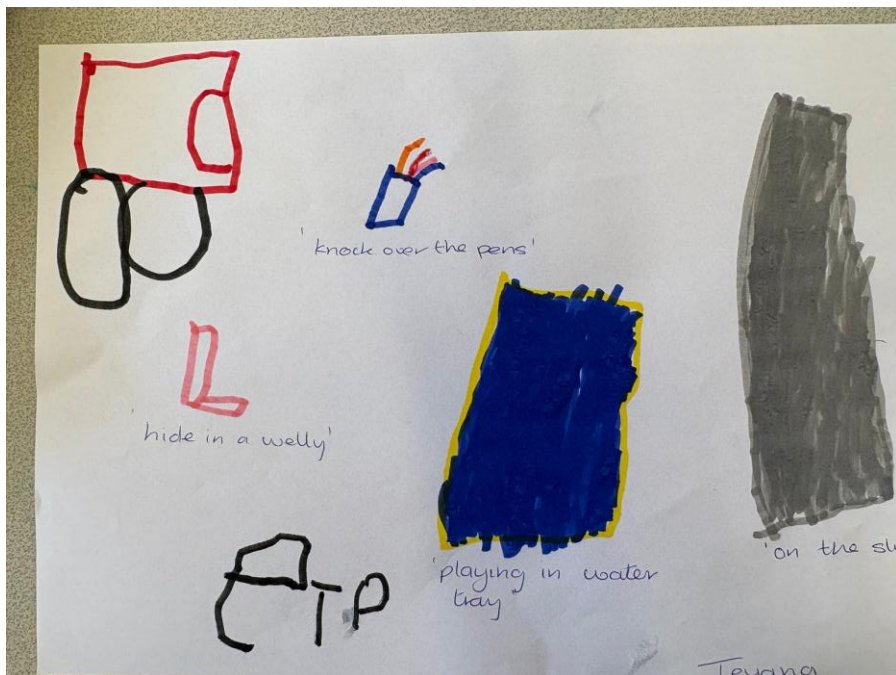
**Dip and Do: Home Learning:**

- Can you show different ways to represent the number three on your fingers?

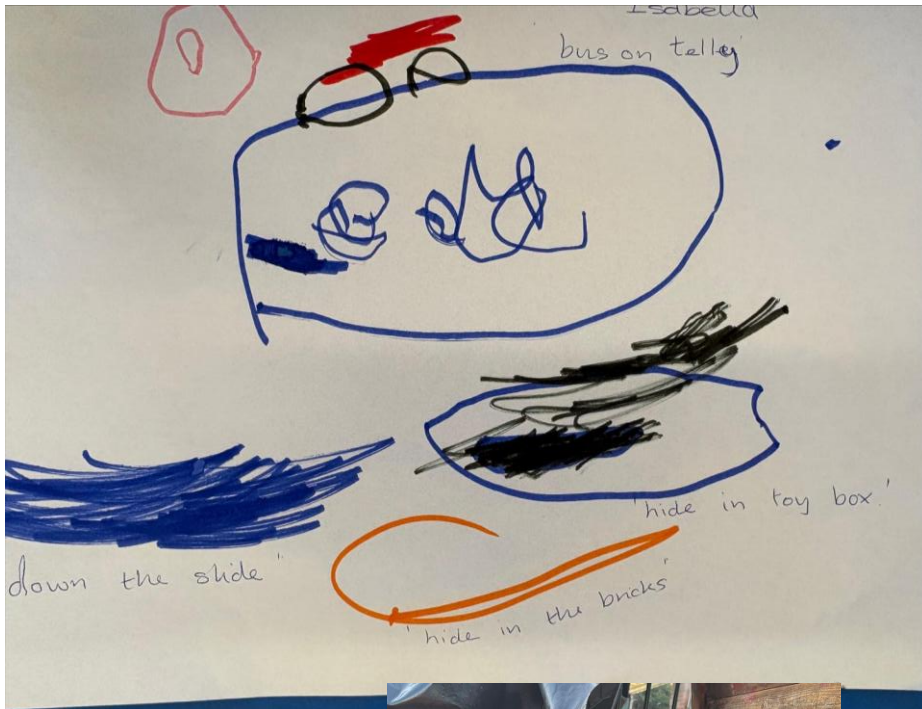

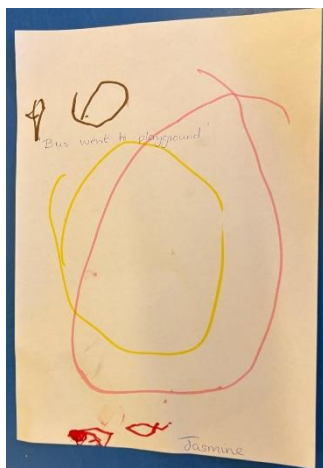

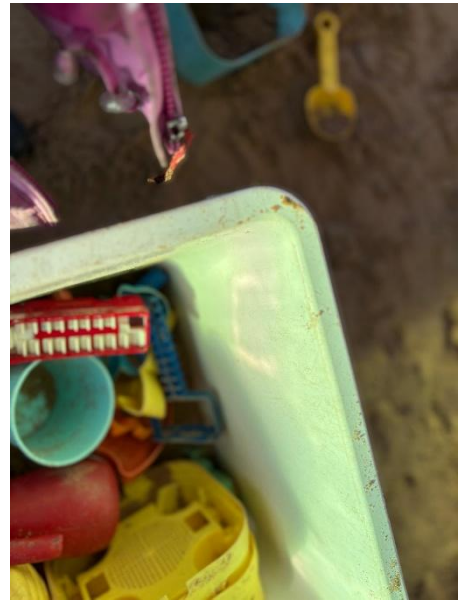


The Naughty Bus by Isabella

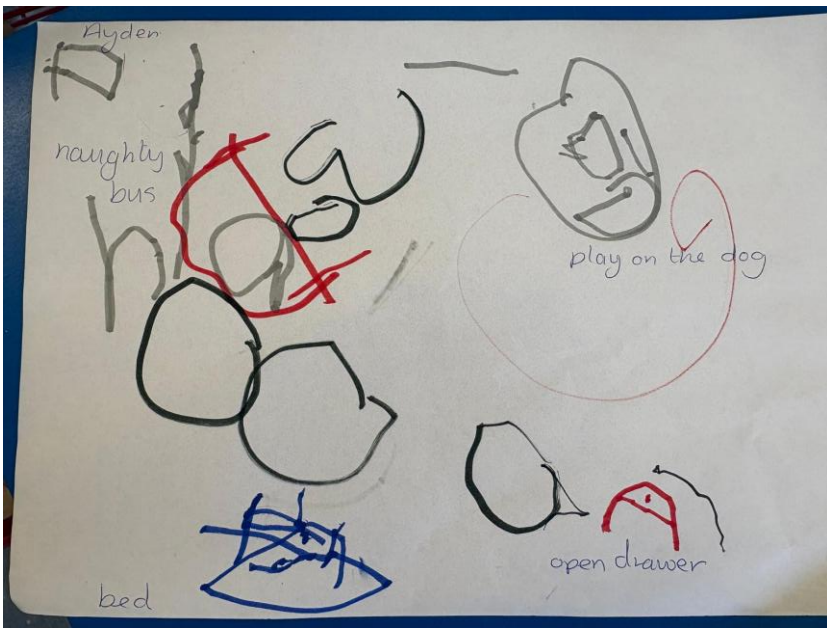

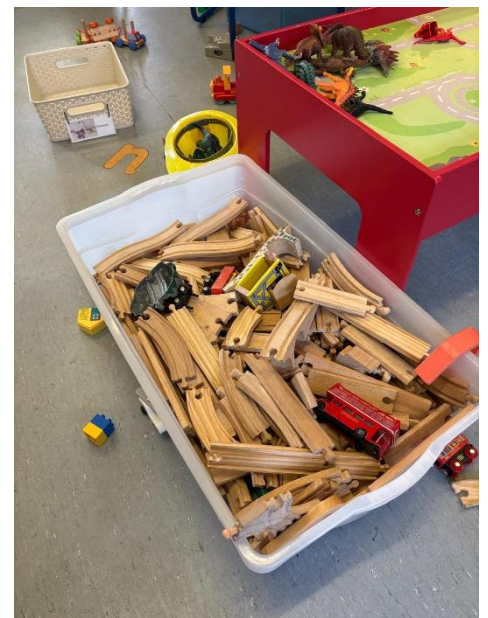
