Weekly News

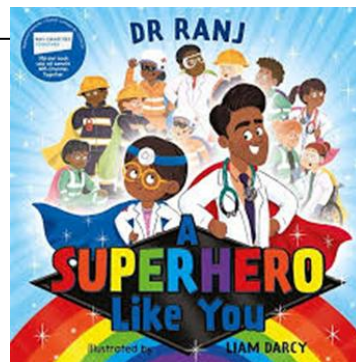

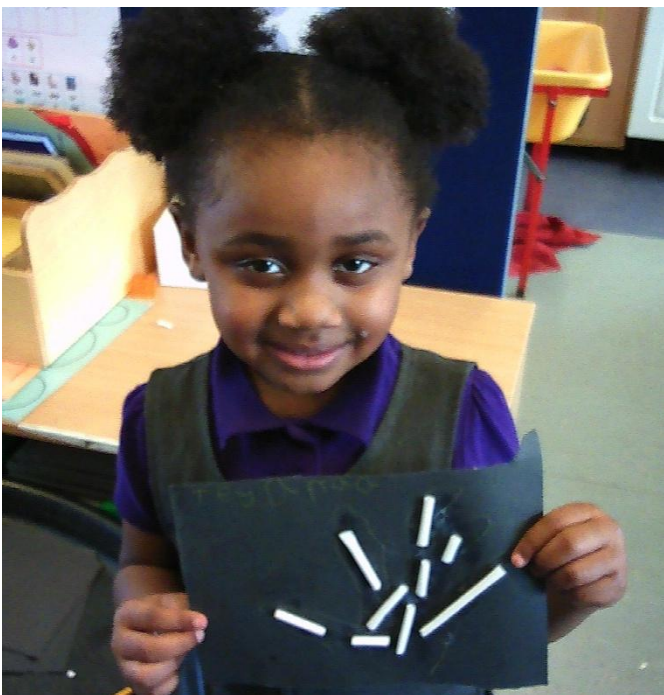
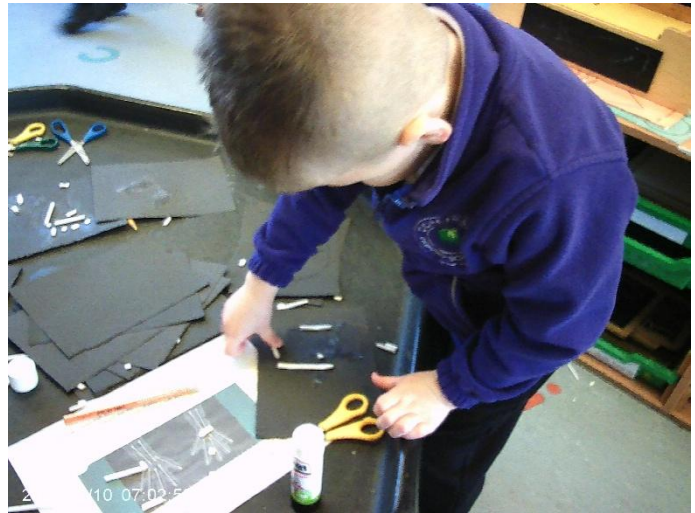
3-a-day Stories: These are our new 3 a day stories for this half term

Phonics

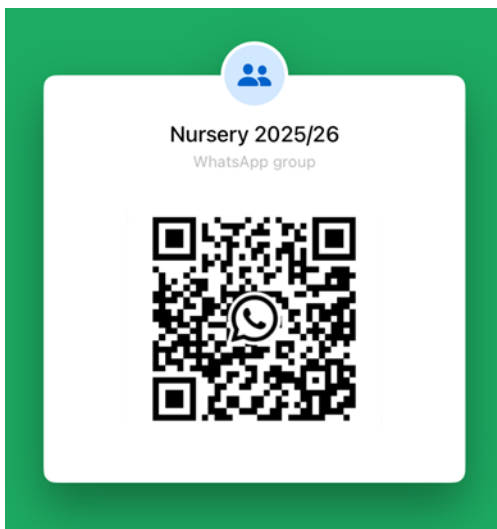
This week we have been leaning the o phoneme sound.
