

Nursery Peek at the Week

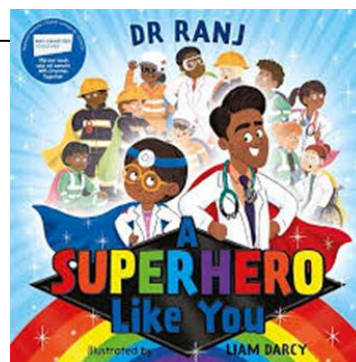
Weekly News

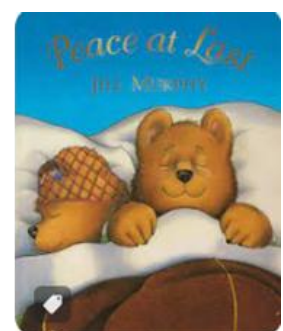
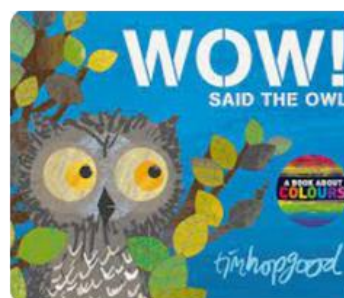

Dip and Do: Home Learning:

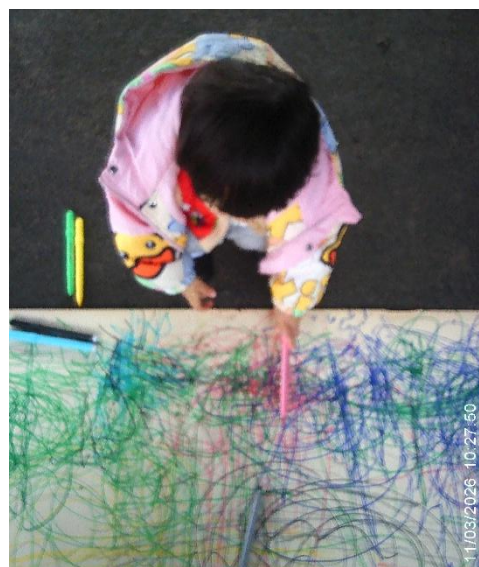
- Can you find out what your family members do for their jobs? We would love to see photographs or maybe you can draw some pictures.

What have we been learning in Nursery this week?

We have been developing our finger muscles by using spray bottles to extinguish shaving foam fires on different houses.

Maths

We have been developing our mathematical knowledge by exploring different ways to make 5, for example $3+2=5$ and $4+1=5$. We are also learning to recognise the numbers to 5 and count out the corresponding number of objects. We have been revising this knowledge in different ways.

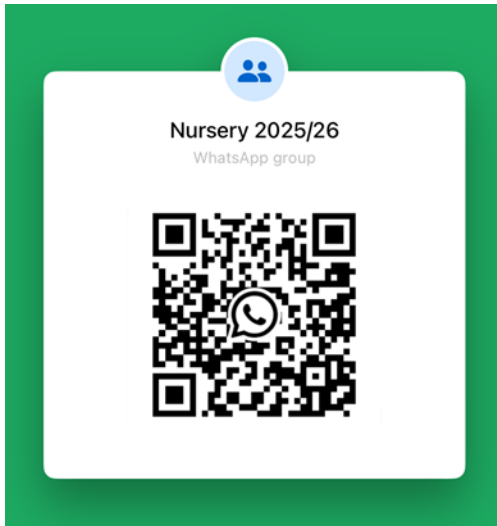
