

## Nursery Peek at the Week

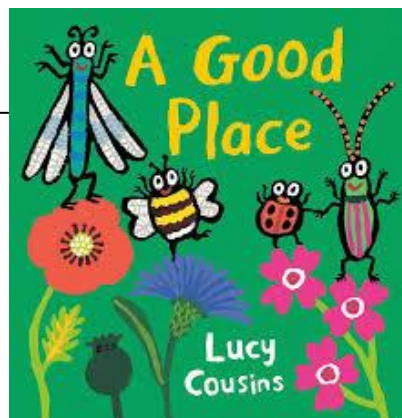
### Weekly News

Welcome back, we hope you all had a lovely Easter and a special welcome to our new families that have joined us in Nursery.

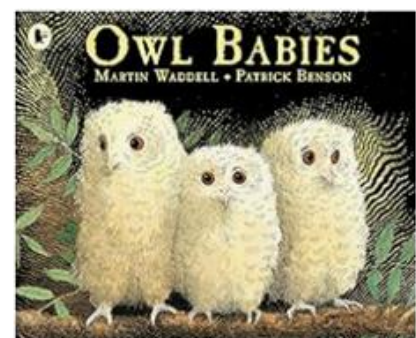
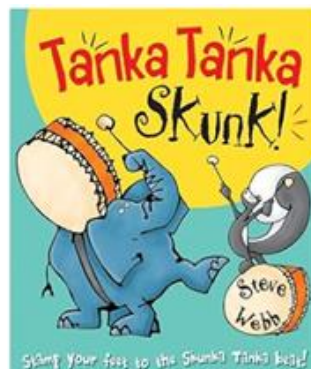

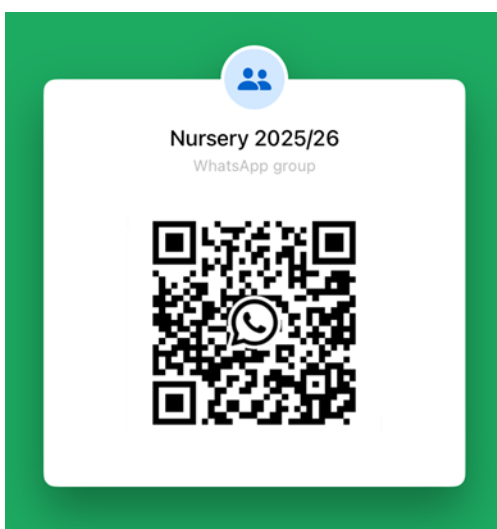
