Enquiry Question of the week

Q: What is the world?

A: The world is made up of continents and oceans. The continents are Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe and Australia. The five oceans are the Pacific Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Southern Ocean and Arctic Ocean.

A summary of the next week:
