

Nursery Peek at the Week

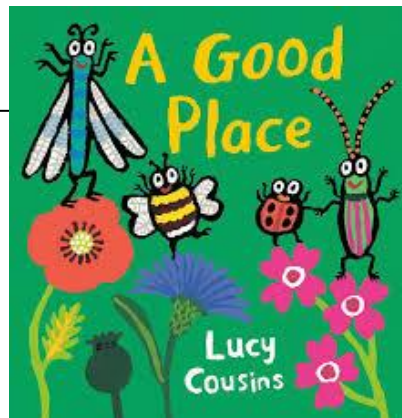
Weekly News

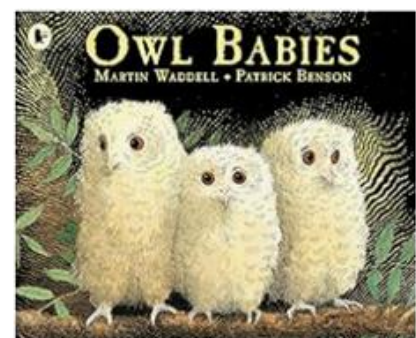
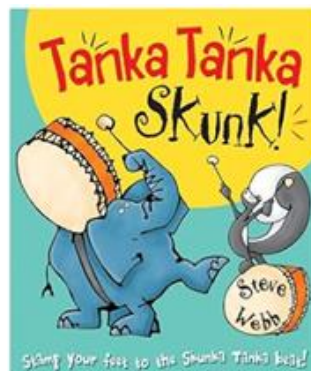
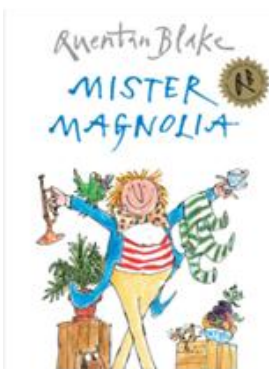
If you have any large cardboard boxes, cardboard tubes or clean plastic yogurt pots please could we have them for next week.

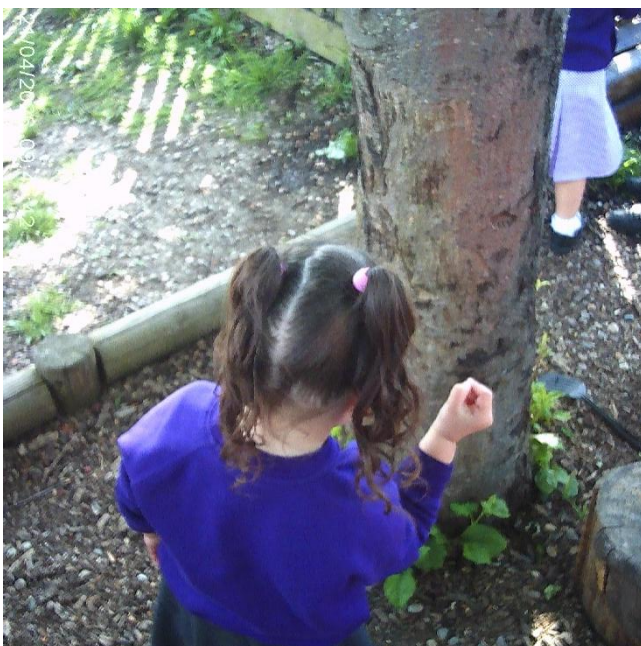
3-a-day Stories: These are our new 3 a day stories for this half term



Dip and Do: Home Learning:

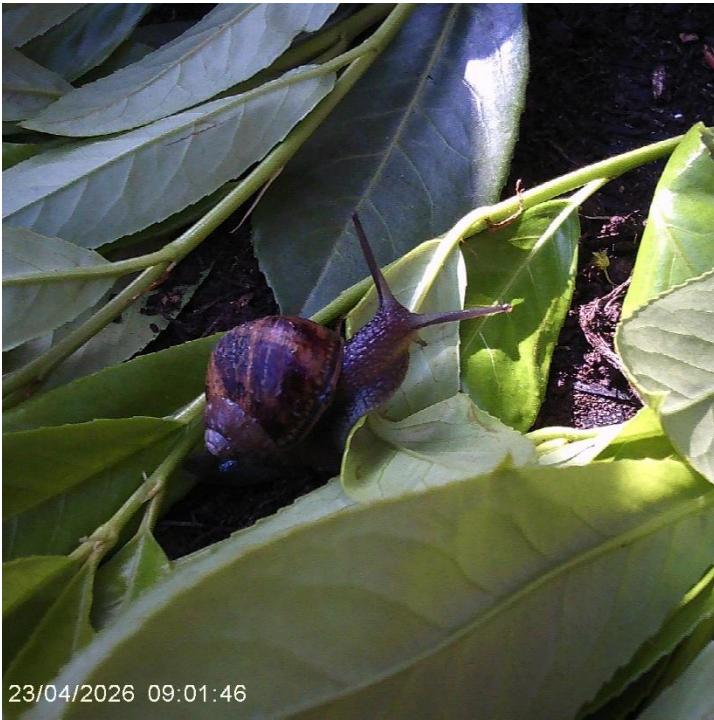
- Can you find objects beginning with e?

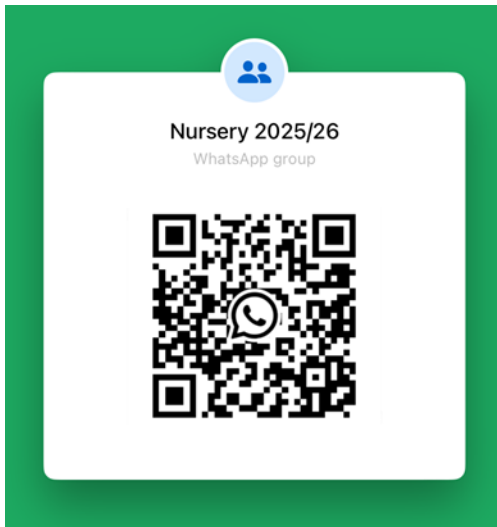
