

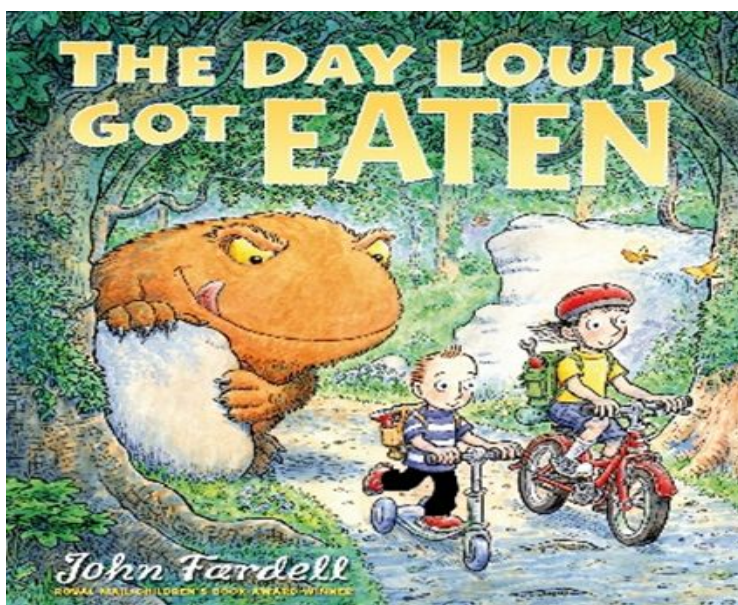
Peek at the Week
