# Year 5 Home Learning - Dip and Do

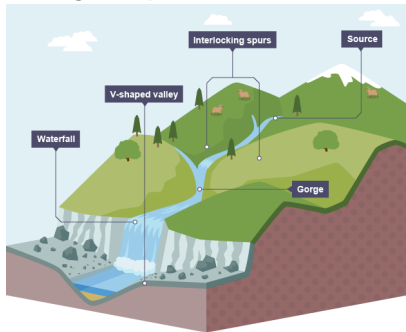
## You must:
