## A summary of the next week:

**Writing:** to understand features of instructions and to write our own instructions about hand washing.

**Maths:** to recognise and find a half of a shape or a quantity.

**Science:** what are the parts of a tree?

**Computing:** making changes to text.

**DT:** to select ingredients for a recipe.

**PSHE:** how are we similar yet different?

**PE:** to explore hopping, jumping and leaping for distance.
