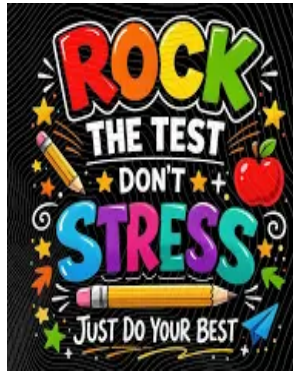
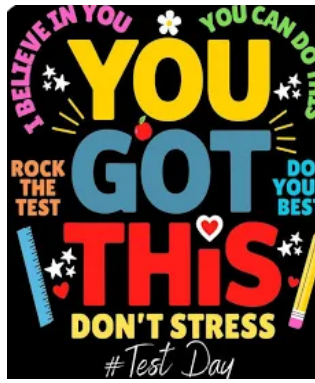
**You must:**
