The Three Little Pigs

We have had a wonderful time enjoying the sunshine this week! We read the fairytale, 'The Three Little Pigs' and the children have been writing their own story maps. Story maps are a great visual tool used to help sequence and understand the structure of a story. The children enjoyed drawing pictures and labelling their story maps and next week we will use them to help retell the story. We experimented with different materials to build houses for the Three Little Pigs. Next week we will test these to see which ones stand up to being blown with a hairdryer! We have also been using our Phonics to write speech bubble sentences. What are the characters saying?

In Maths, we have been making numbers between 10 and 20 using ten frames and counters.



Sun Hats and Sun Cream

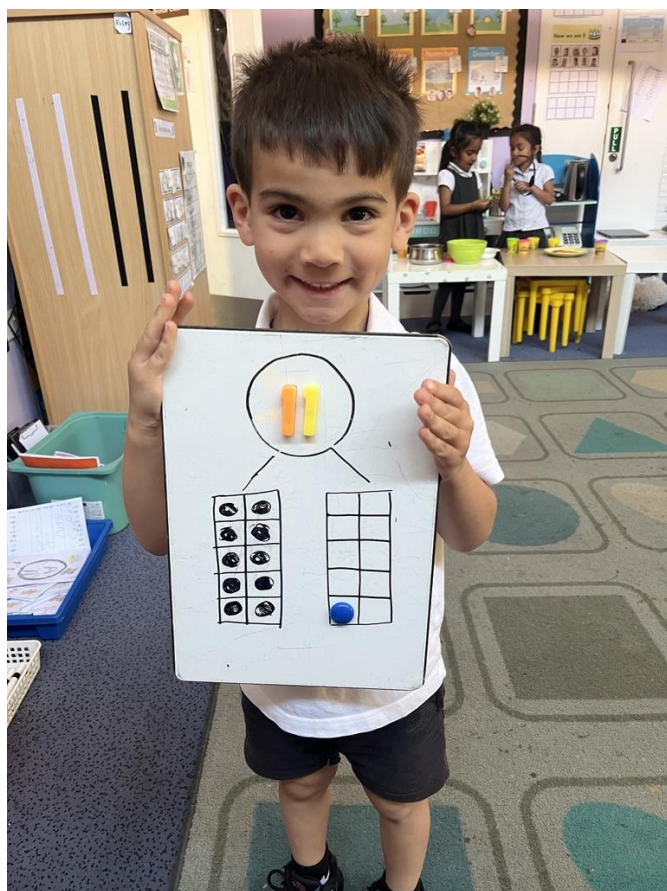

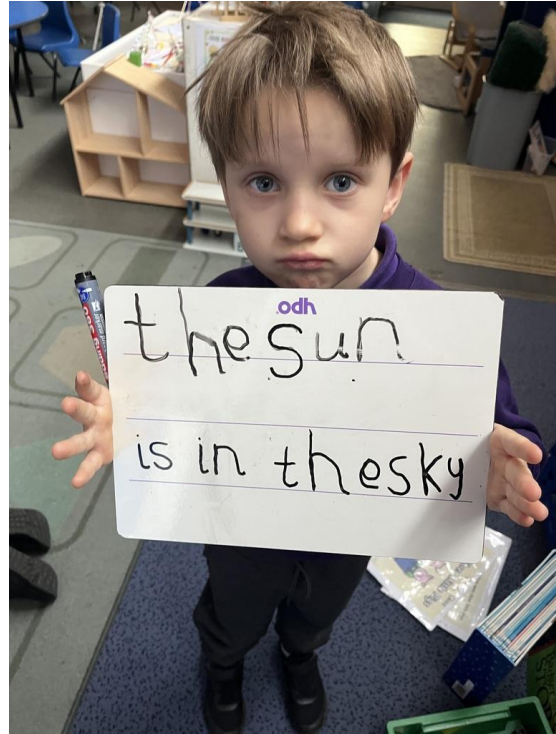
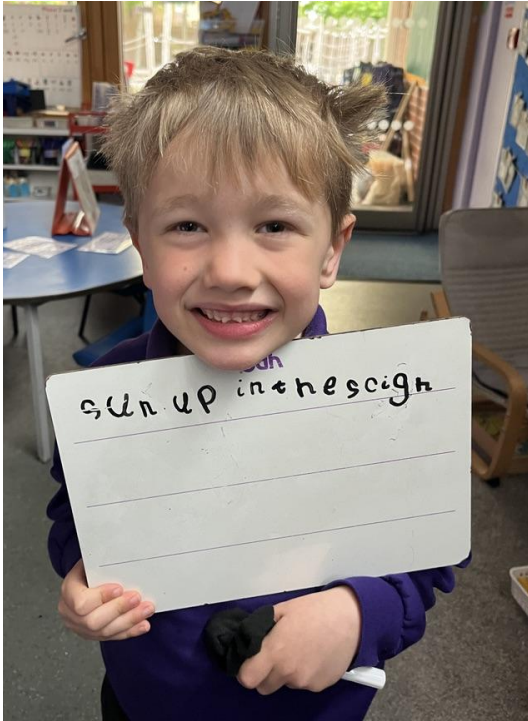


Working together to make a house for one of the Three Little Pigs.

How do you make numbers bigger than 10?



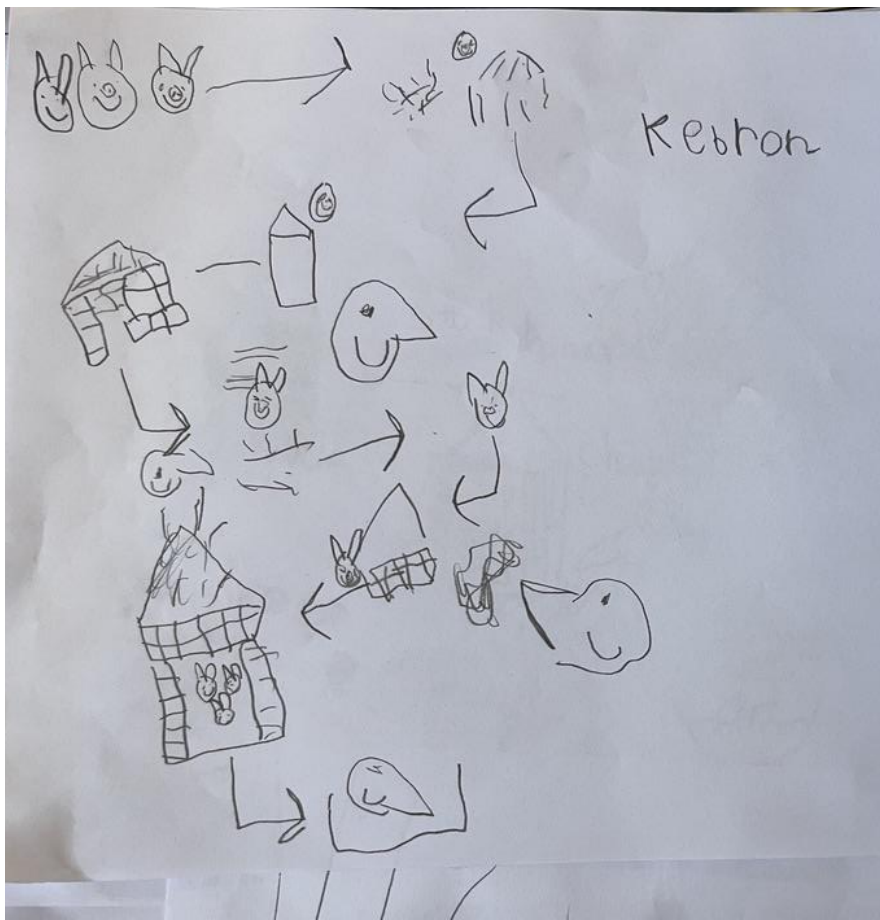
Please share these photographs with your children and encourage them to tell you what they have learnt this week.
