Enquiry Question of the week

Are there any food chains happening in our allotment?

Year 2 Home Learning - "Dip and Do" Summer Term



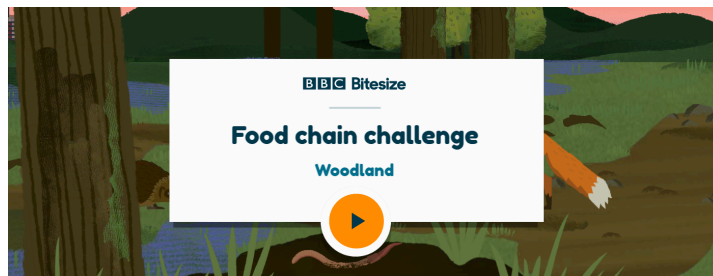
You must:
