Things to know:

Enquiry Question of the week

Q: What is the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees?

A: Deciduous trees lose their leaves typically in Autumn but evergreen trees do not.

A summary of the next week:

Phonics: ph saying /f/, wh saying /w/, ie saying /ee/, g saying /j/

Reading: Little wandle reading groups x3.

Writing: Write instructions to make a smoothie.

Maths: Describe turns (half turn, quarter turn, three-quarter turn) and positions (left, right, forwards, backwards, above, below).

RE: What stories are special to Hindus?

Science: Can you compare some common plants and trees?

Computing: Pencil or keyboard?

DT: To evaluate against the design brief.

Geography: What is it like to live in a hot climate?

PSHE: What are democratic decisions?

PE: To develop throwing for accuracy.
