Things to know:

- ★ The children have come home with updated personalised phonics sheets. These have the specific sounds and words your child is struggling with so please support them with practising these.
- ★ Next week is the Phonics Screening Check. This is a government given test (like the SATS in Year 6). We have been preparing for this for a long time so the children are ready and we will not be telling them that this is the official one, so that they are not nervous! If your child does not pass the screening test this year, they will have to retake it next year so we want as many children to pass as possible. Enquiry Question of the week

Q: What types of transport do you know and when would you use each one?

A: Cars, trains, buses, planes, bikes, boats and tubes.

Bicycle: This is a good way to travel if you only have to go somewhere that is not too far away.

Bus: Buses, or coaches, can be used to travel on land.

Planes: when you are travelling further away - overseas.

Cars: better for getting to places that are hard to reach on other methods of transport.
