## All Aboard the London Bus

This week we have read *All Aboard the London Bus* by Patty Toht. We explored some famous London landmarks including Big Ben, the London Eye, Buckingham Palace, Tower Bridge, and the Tower of London. We also had discussions about where London is and why it is important.

In addition, we have been looking at the life cycles of butterflies and frogs, and we have been learning new vocabulary like **frogspawn**, **froglets**, **tadpole**, **caterpillar**, and **chrysalis**.

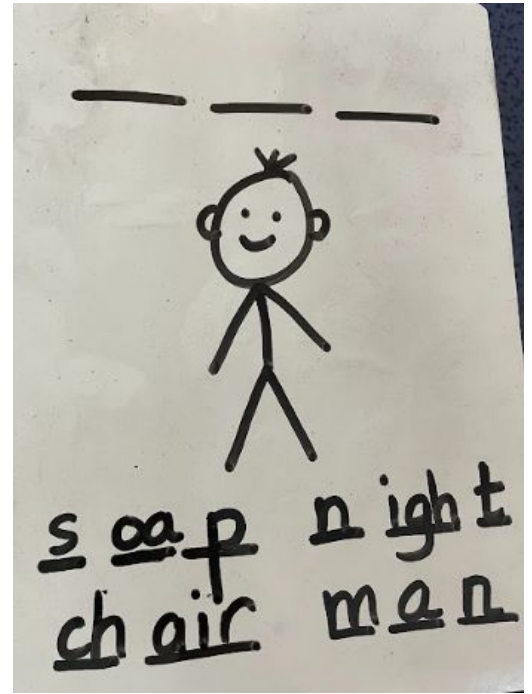
### New set of Tricky Words

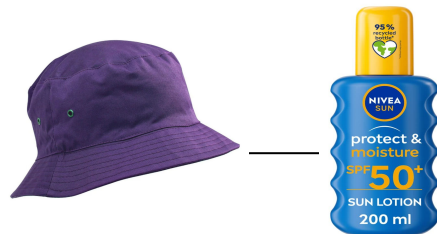
## Happy Man

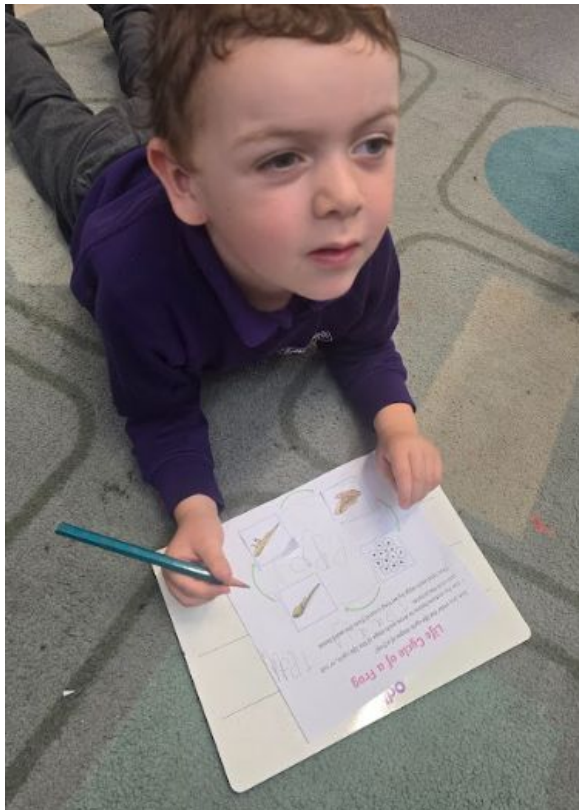

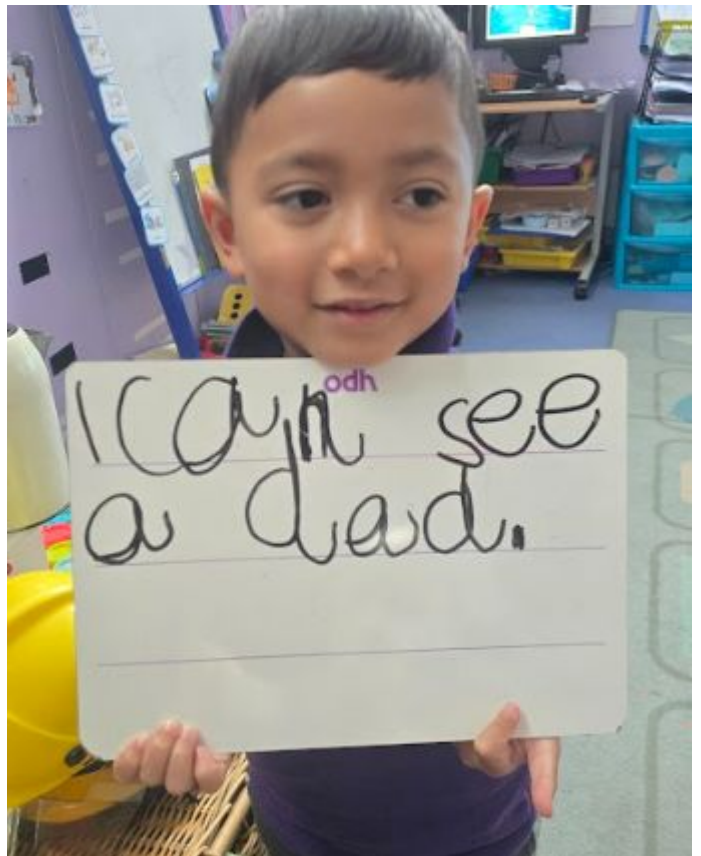
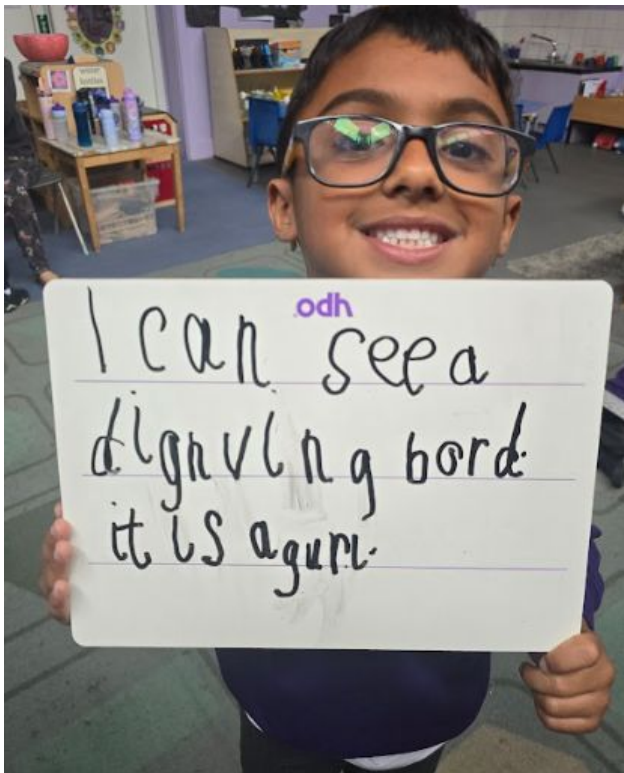
In art, we have been learning about different ways to join materials together. We had a go at making pop-up cards and books. Look at their amazing creations!

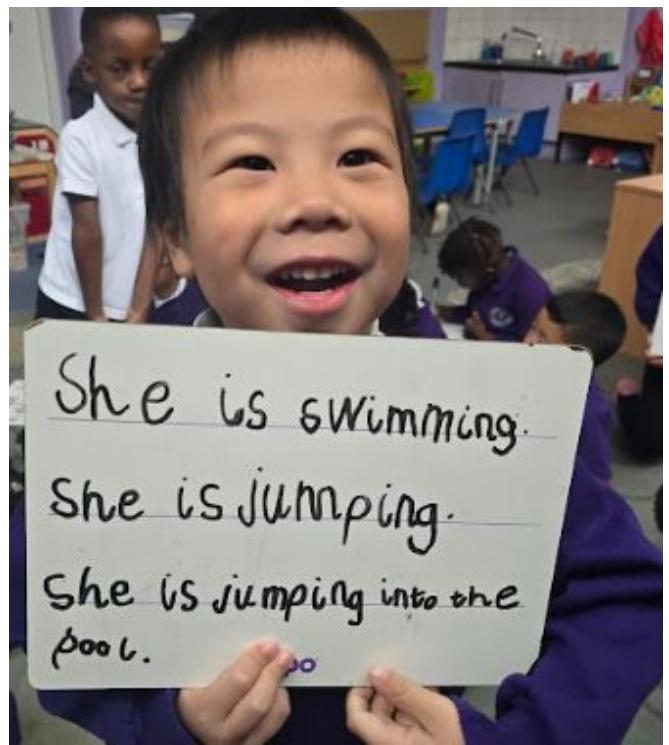
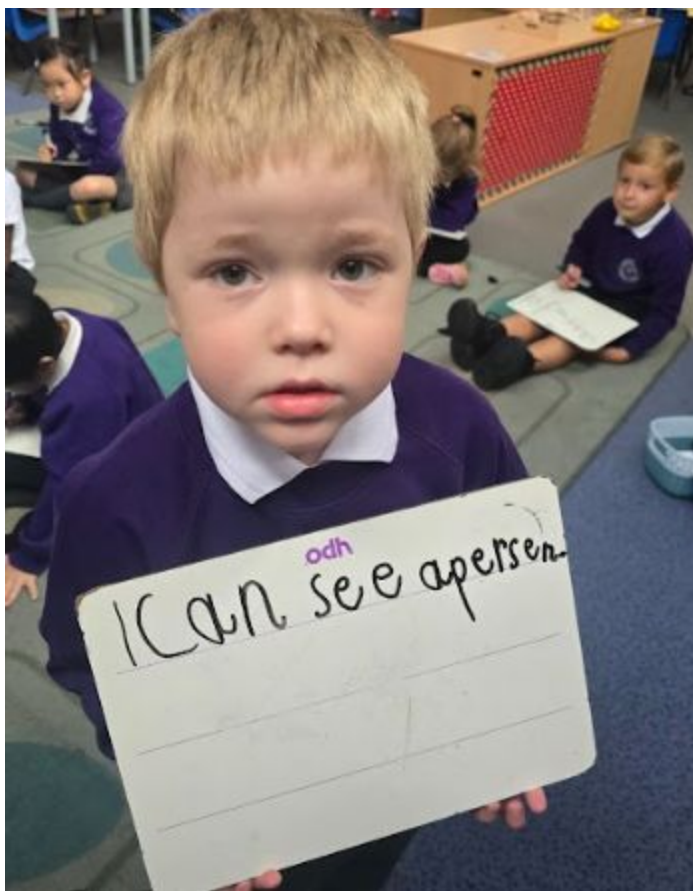


We also had a go at creating diagrams of life cycles and labelling them.

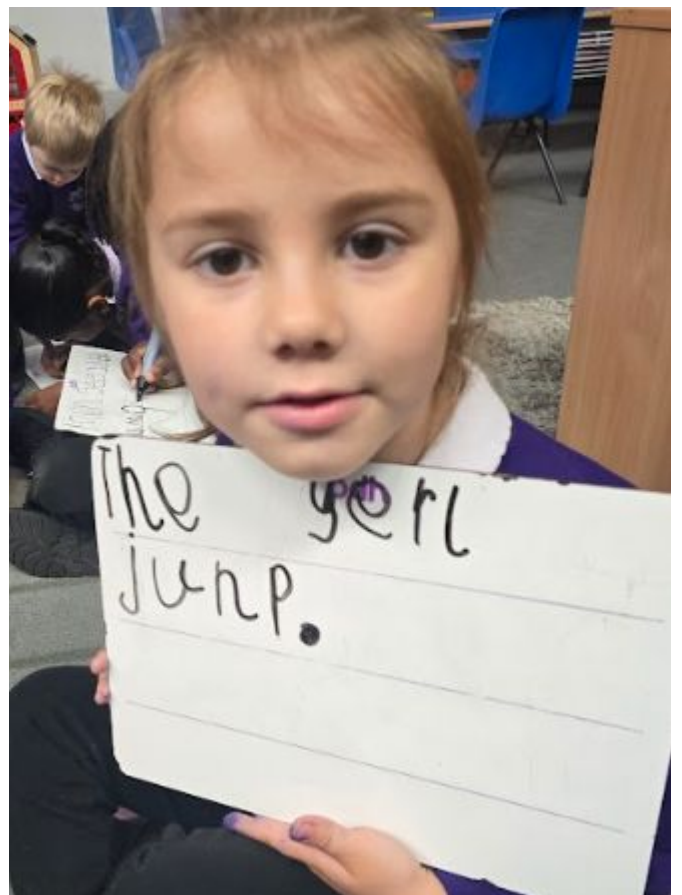
