3-a-day Stories: This half term we will be reviewing our 3-a-day stories to ensure that the children are confidently able to retell them.



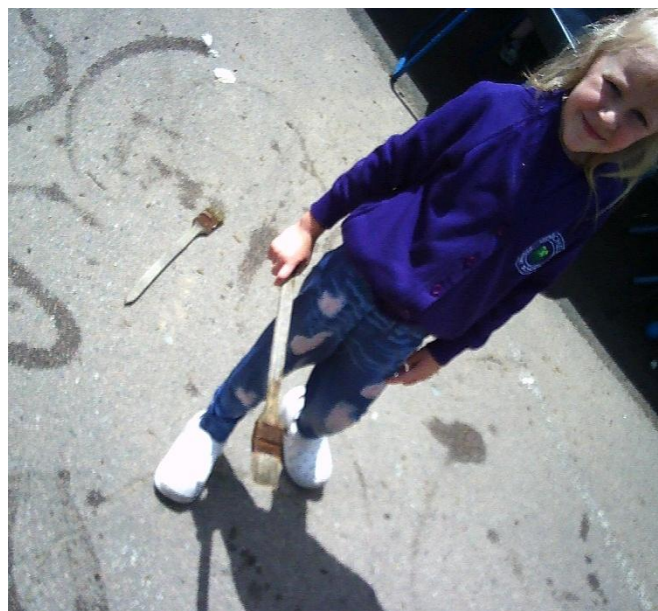
Dip and Do: Home Learning:

Around the duck's body, up to its head and down to its feet.



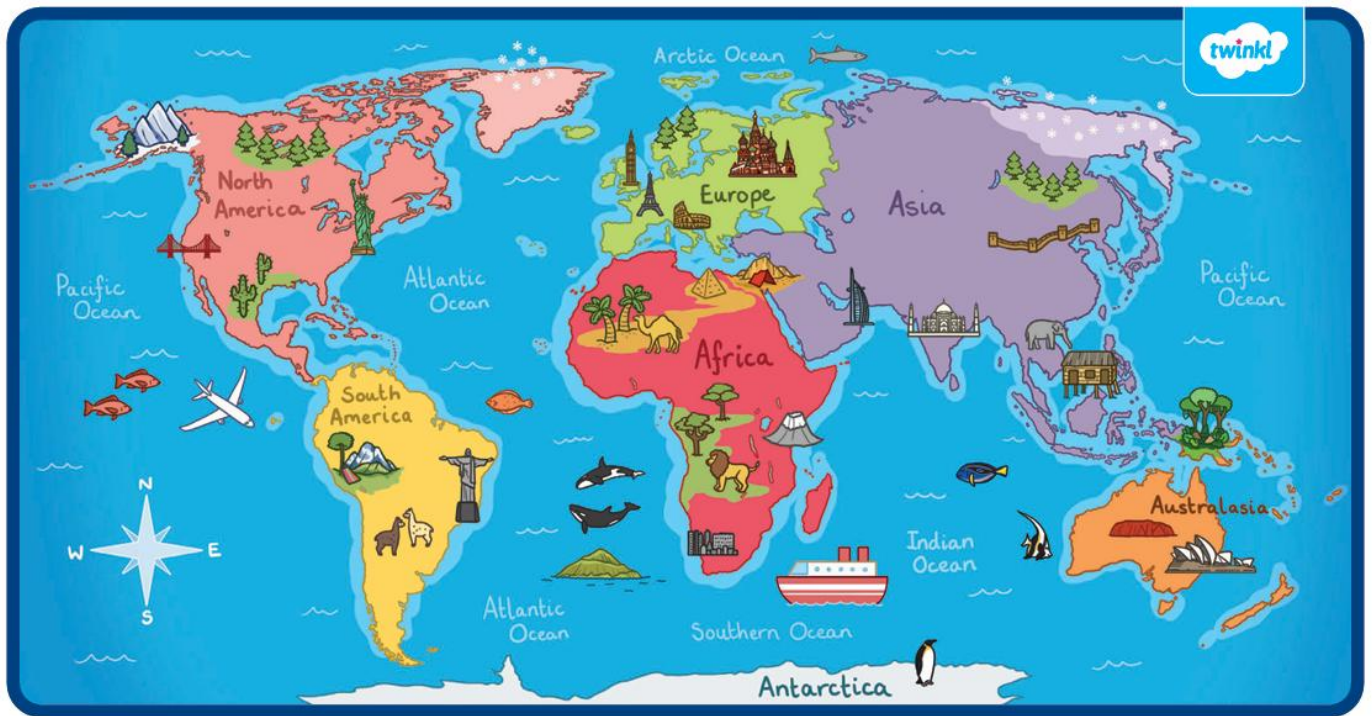














Phonics

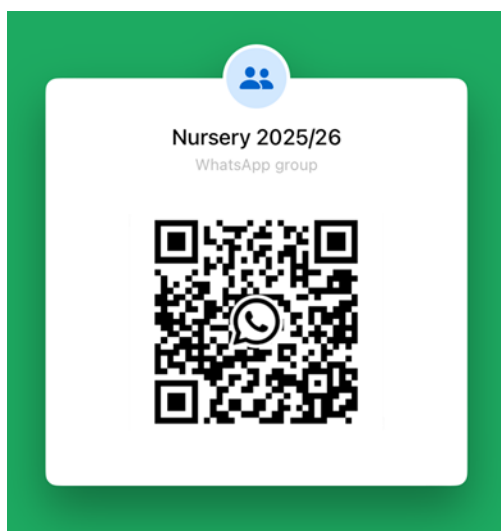
