We have been super scientists and experimented to see how we can use forces to make objects move. We have found out that heavy objects are harder to move but when you push something down a slope it requires less force. We have also learnt that gravity is a force that pulls objects back to Earth.

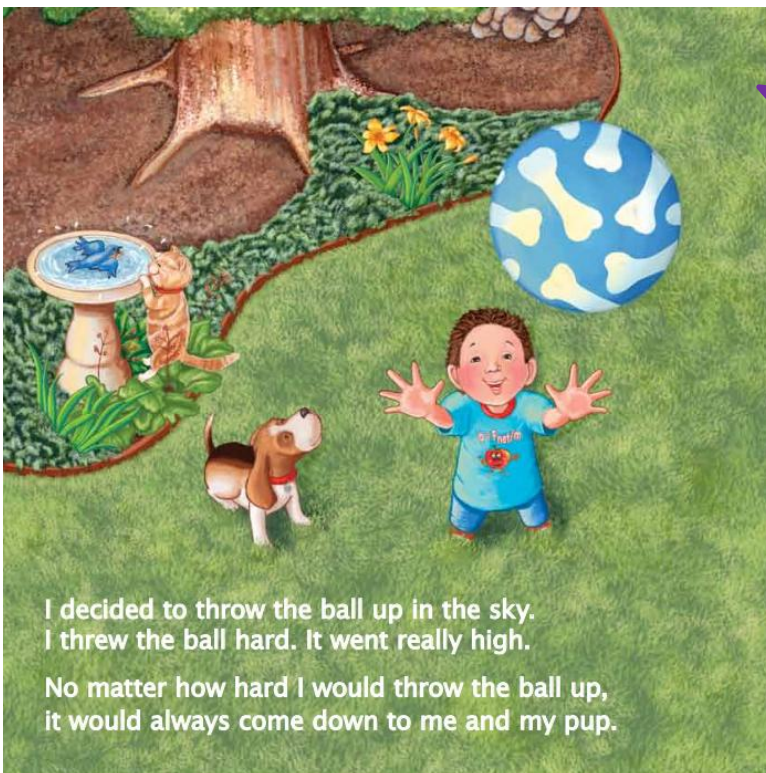
3-a-day Stories: This half term we will be reviewing our 3-a-day stories to ensure that the children are confidently able to retell them.

What have we been learning in Nursery this week?

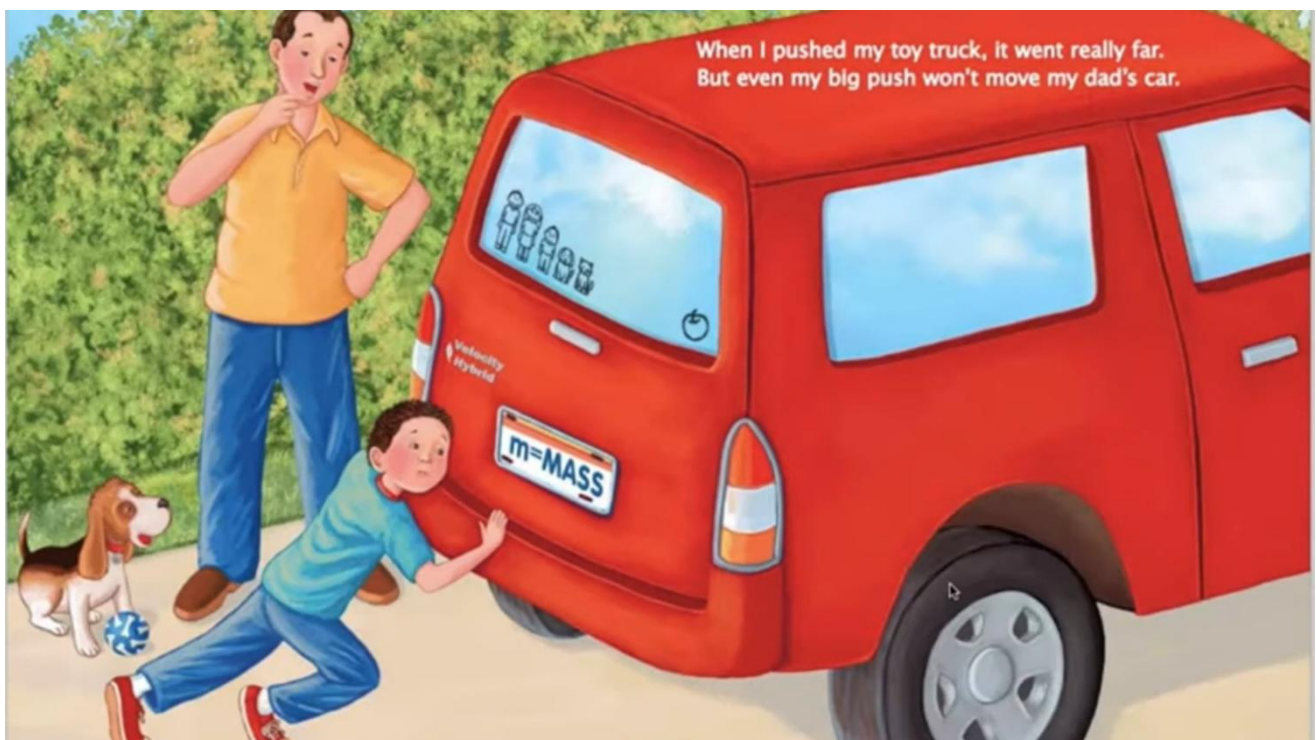


I decided to throw the ball up in the sky.

Until I would push, my truck stayed where it sat.



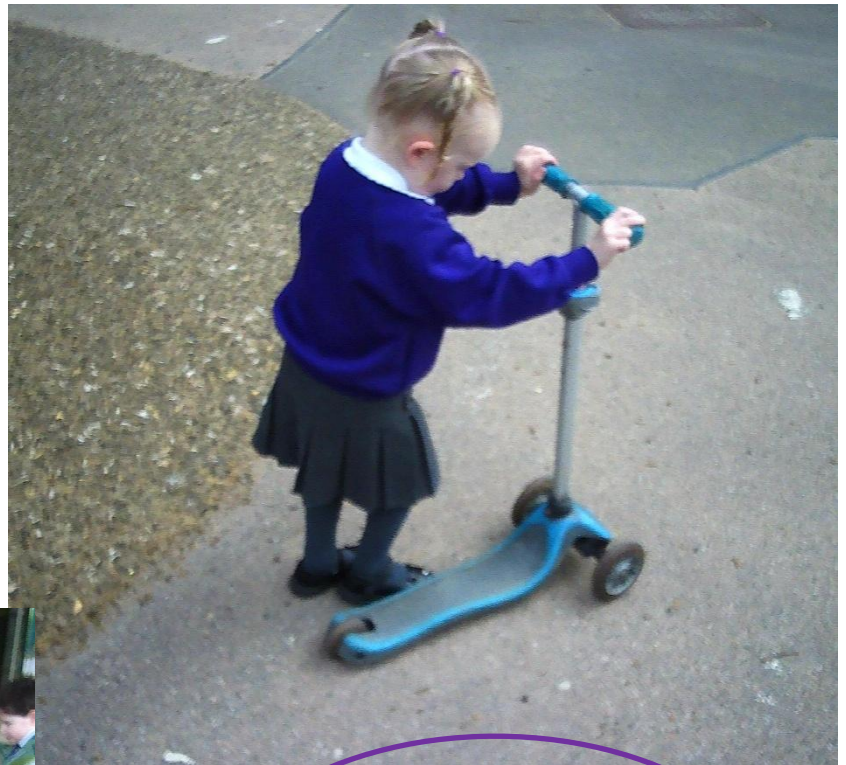


But going downhill, I needed to slow down.
I did that by dragging my feet on the ground.

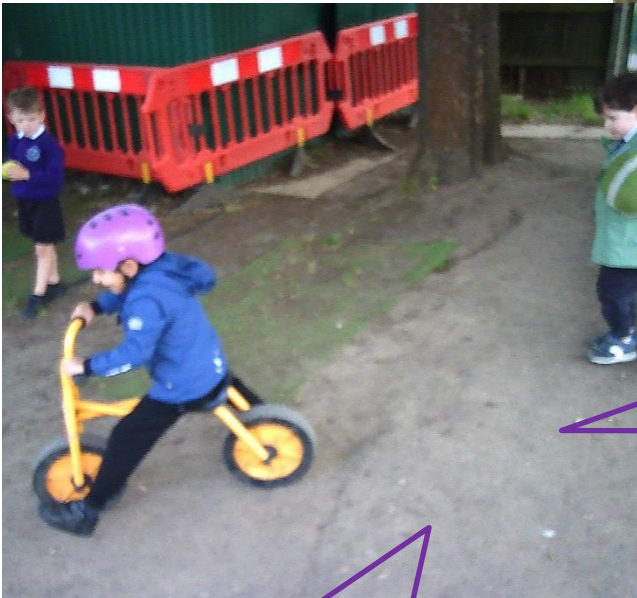

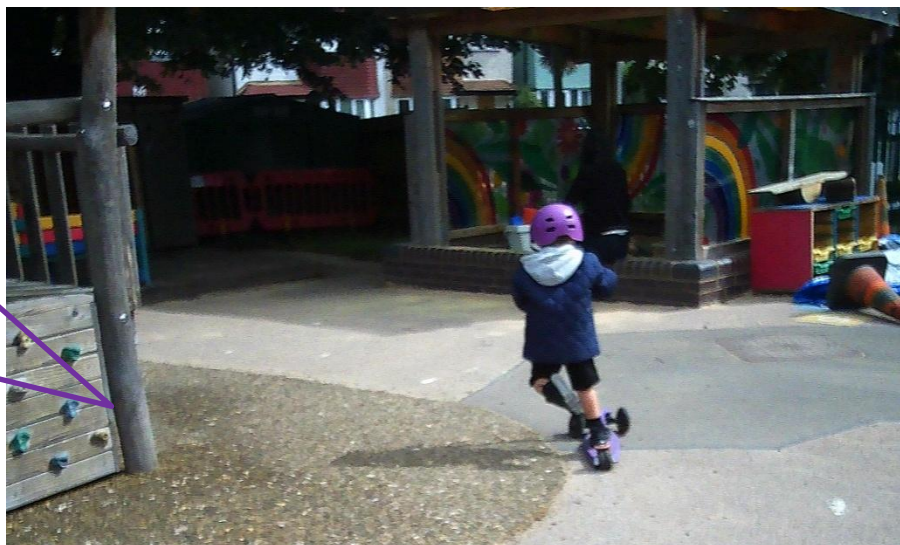

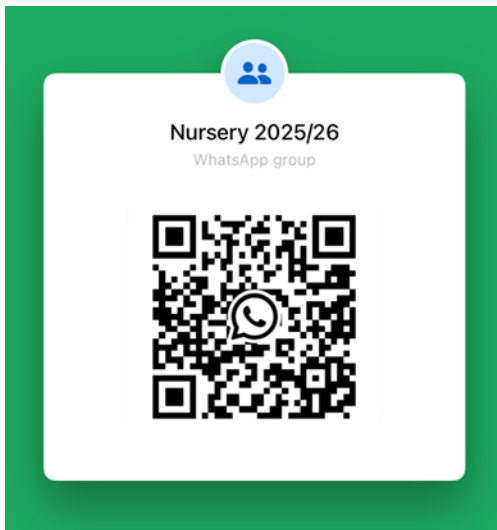
