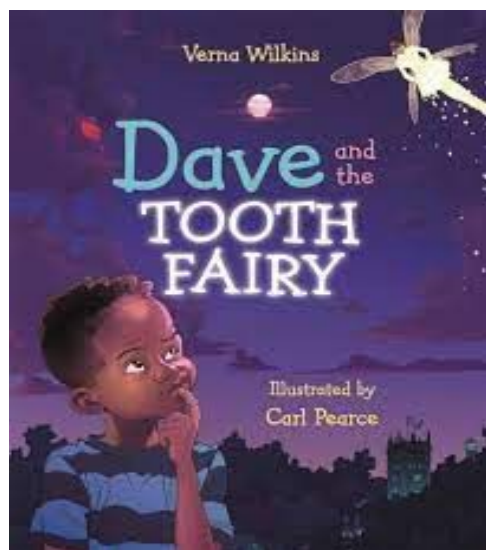
Dave and the Tooth Fairy
