### Weekly News

This week in Nursery we have been very hot! We have been learning how to stay safe in the sun. We have been applying lots of sun cream, and we know that it is important to make sure that we do not burn. We have also been taking lots of 'hydration breaks' and we have learnt that drinking lots of water is essential. We were also very lucky because some of our parents donated ice lollies, so these were a very tasty way to stay cool and hydrated. We have also been experimenting to make our own ice balloons; we realised that we cannot fit blocks of ice into the opening of the balloon but we can fill them with water and put them in a freezer and when the water freezes it makes ice. We have also been learning about paddling pool safety and we know that we should not go into a paddling pool if an adult is not there.

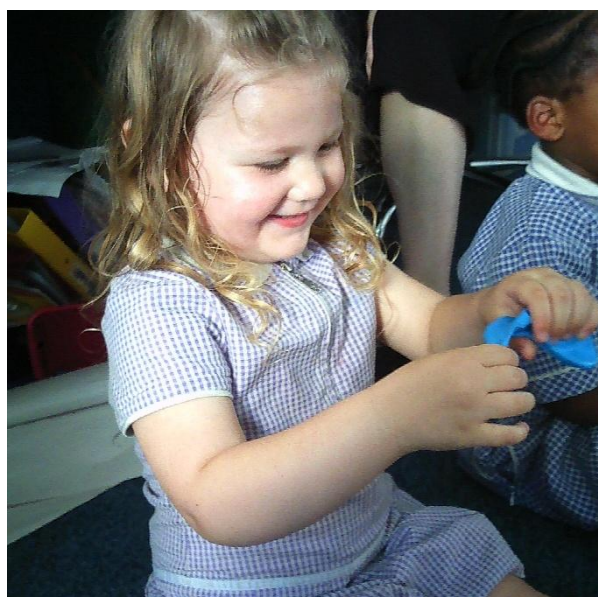


How does a balloon feel when it is empty?

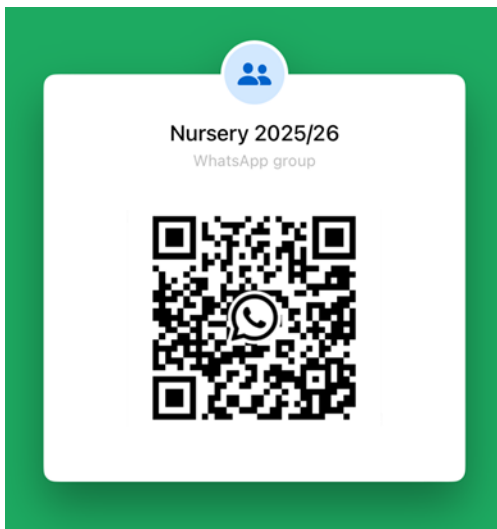
