Early Birds - Ideas for Summer and Sports Day

Sports Day for the Reception children will be taking place on Friday 10th July 9.15 – 10.15am on the field.

Families are very welcome to come and watch the children take part in 6 different activities based around some of the core movement skills, such as running, throwing with accuracy and balancing, that they have been developing over the past year.

If you are coming to the Early Birds session, at 8:30am, in the Reception Classrooms, we will all walk up to the field together. Otherwise, please enter the field via the gate from the park – a member of staff will open the gate for access at 9.15am when the children have arrived on the field.

We will let you know which colour team your child is in for this event and if they would like to wear suitable clothes for PE in that colour on the day they are very welcome to do so but this is not compulsory. They are very welcome to wear their usual school PE kit instead if they would prefer or if you do not have anything appropriate in their team colour.

The children must wear trainers please to ensure they can complete all the activities safely.

*Please ensure the children have their **named water bottle** as usual and according to the weather forecast **wear sun cream, sun hats or rain jackets** as required.*

Should there be light rain and the field is safe to use we will aim to go ahead, similarly if it is due to be very hot we will decide if it is safe and suitable for the children to be outside for the duration of the event.

Should conditions not be appropriate to go ahead we will postpone the event and inform everyone as soon as possible.

We look forward to welcoming you to see the children in action on 10th July!
