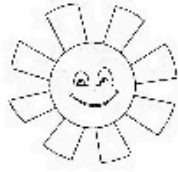
In Science this week we were talking about hygiene. We took part in a little experiment where we used cocoa powder to highlight how germs can stay on our hands if we don't wash them properly.



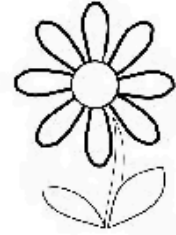
Can you write a list of things we must do regularly to stay clean?

Time for fun, and lots of sun.

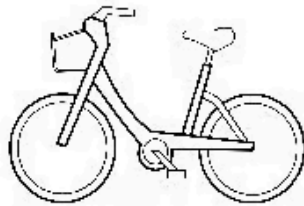
I love these kinds of days!
