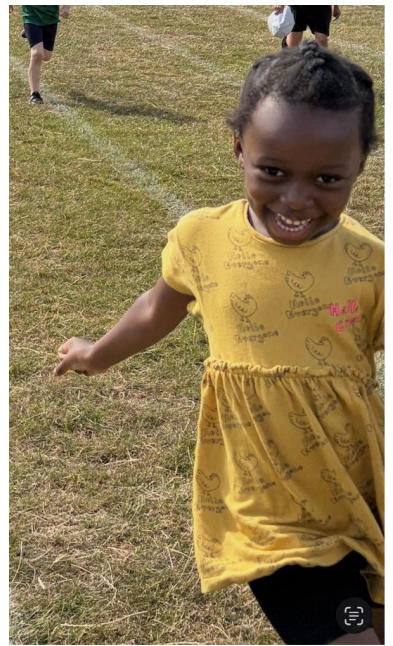
























Mystery reader
