Enquiry Question of the week

Each week we will post an Enquiry Question from the week's learning alongside the answer we would expect. Ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can work on learning more at home.

Who led the Roman invasions in Britain and were they a success or failure and why?

Julius Caesar led the first Roman invasions (55 and 54 BC), which were failures at establishing control, while Emperor Claudius launched the invasion in 43 AD, which was a success.
