

Peek into next week Year 3

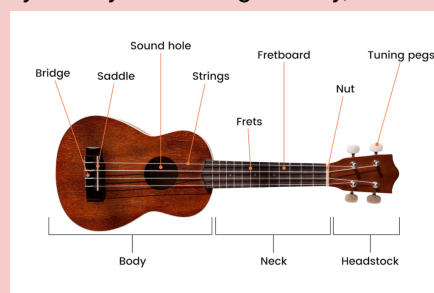
Things to know:
