### Enquiry Question of the week

## How can the shape of materials be changed?

This week, in Science, we explored different materials and tested to see if they could be stretched, bent, twisted or squashed. The children explored a range of materials and had to make predictions about what they would be able to do to each item, in order to change.

**Science:** Can you identify which materials are natural and man-made?

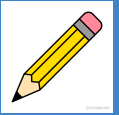
