Enquiry Question of the week

Please take some time to ask your child the question and see how close your child is to answering the question fully. If they are finding it tricky, break down the answer together and see if they can continue to work on their learning at home.

What are the careers we can have in medicine and how have they changed over time?

Technology over time has improved, so instead of one doctor for everything, we now have specialists; for example orthopaedic surgeons, paediatricians for babies/ children and dentists for teeth. Nurses, who take care of us when we're in the hospital, now do many important things and make sure we feel better. There are also scientists who discover new ways to help us, like finding cures for illnesses.
