Bonfire Night and Remembrance

We have had a very busy week learning about Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day. The children have used salad spinners and paint to create firework pictures. The children have made their own fireworks using a range of materials. We have also learnt the 'Remember, Remember the 5th of November' rhyme.

For Remembrance Day, we have talked about why people wear poppies and how important specific animals were in helping the soldiers in the War. The children have enjoyed painting fields of poppies and have used their counting skills to make poppies using multilink cubes. The children were moved by the CBeebies video, 'Poppies' which shows a rabbit and his friend, the snail, as they navigate the fields of war before the poppie grew.

On the writing table, the children have been practising their names and writing the initial sounds they can hear in cvc words (such as log, net, bus and pig). In Forest School, we went on a 'I Spy Hunt' and ticked off the things we could find around the school including our lovely Willow Tree and the chickens!

On **Friday 17th November** the children can dress up in the theme of Nursery Rhymes. It can be any nursery rhyme of your child's choice.


Reading and Reading Records


Dip and Do
