Nursery Peek at the Week

Weekly News

In Nursery this week, we have been looking at the story of 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers as we continue to explore different ways to travel. In this book, the boy rows a boat but the penguin sails in an umbrella! We have been trying to make boats that float by experimenting with different building materials. This book also focuses on friendship and helping each other so we have been thinking about what makes a good friend and how we can help our friends at Nursery. The children enjoyed creating their own penguins by joining different parts together. They also practised using scissors safely by having a go at making the penguin's feet and beak. Just like the boy in the story, the children made their own telescopes using their fingers to manipulate paper. In Maths, we have been learning about capacity and mass using wrapped up presents in different sizes. The children enjoyed exploring and making predictions about what could be inside.


Dip and Do


These are some ideas of things that you may like to do to support your child's learning at home.


- Can you make a boat that floats? What materials could you use?


Squiggle Whilst You Wiggle incorporates dance, music and large movements to help children develop the fine muscle control they need for writing.

We have been using small world toys to retell the Lost and Found story.








What shapes did you choose to make your penguin? How did you hold the scissors safely?

What will you see on your adventure?


































