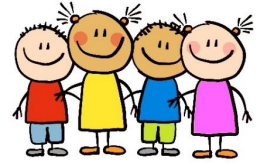


Peek at the Week



The Christmas Nativity

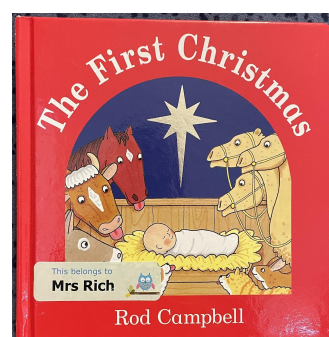
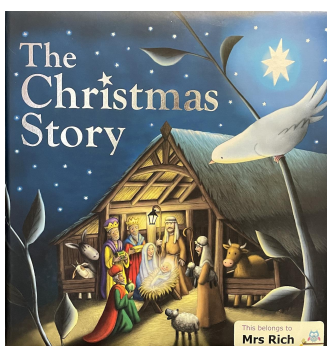
The children started this week by performing a Hanukkah song in whole school assembly. They sang so well and it was a great opportunity, ahead of their nativity, to perform in front of an audience.

We have been reading the story of the Nativity. We have read it from more than one book because we learned that the story is so old that we are not sure who the original author is but lots of people have written versions that we can read. It also put the children's own Nativity Performance into context- they even started singing the songs from their Nativity while we were reading the story.

In Maths we have been revising our knowledge of how to make numbers 1-5

On Friday both classes went to Forest School to roast marshmallows and play hoop games.

This week both classes have been visited by cute little elves called Pip and Pop. Each morning they have been caught doing something around the classroom. The children write to the elves to suggest activities they might like to do. We have been decorating Christmas trees and dressing up in Christmassy outfits.

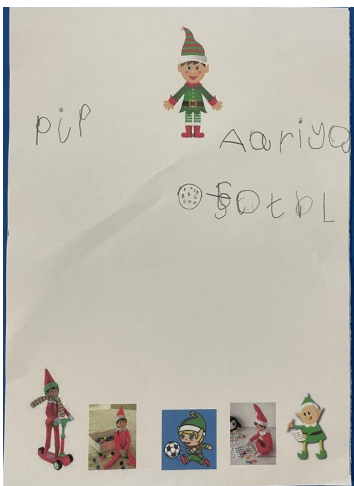
The children singing One Little Candle in Assembly.



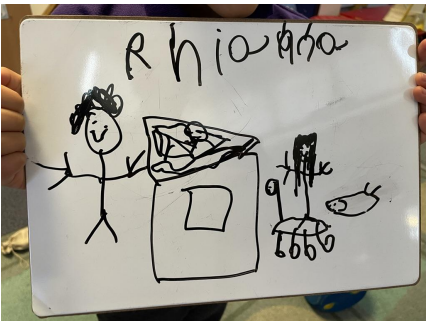
King Herod practising his lines. He is doing a great job of looking mean
