### Things to know

A: The Tudor period was between 1485 and 1603, after the Vikings and before the Great Fire of London. The 6 Tudor monarchs were Henry VII, Henry VIII, Edward VI, Lady Jane Grey, Mary I and Elizabeth I.

Answers to include facts about a few of the monarchs, from the children's research.
