Enquiry Question of the week

EQ: Who was John Blanke and what does the Westminster roll tell us about him?

A: John Blanke was a trumpeter in the Tudor palace. He is depicted in the Westminster Tournament Roll of 1511. It is believed that John was living here from 1501, where he arrived with Catherine of Aragon on a galleon from Spain. He was well respected, as he performed at both Henry VII's funeral and Henry VIII's coronation. He was paid wages and we have evidence he was given a pay rise after requesting one. He was even given a wedding present by Henry VIII in 1512.
