

Enquiry Question of the week

EQ: How is the water cycle a never ending loop?

A: The water cycle is the process by which the world's water moves between lakes, rivers, the atmosphere, oceans and land. As it moves through this system the water changes state. It can be liquid (water), gas (vapour), or solid (ice). The main processes involved in the water cycle are the evaporation of water, the formation of condensation, precipitation when rain and snow falls and, run-off/accumulation and transpiration. Water continues to move in this way in a never-ending loop.
