Things to know

Enquiry Question

EQ: What is the journey of a river from source to mouth?

A river has three main stages: upper course, middle course and lower course (You will need to go into detail about each stage). As rivers travel they become slower, wider and deeper. When they flow more quickly, they transport more sediment; when they travel more slowly, they deposit this sediment (this creates a meander). Almost all rivers end their journey by reaching a sea or an ocean.

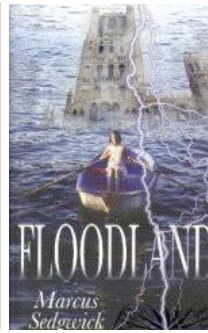
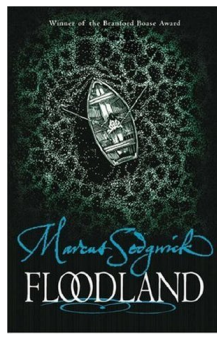
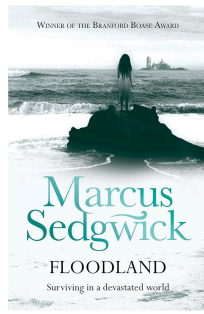
