


Can you do a somersault / roly poly / forward roll?

Gymnasts in the making! Doing a forward roll on a rope.




Have you signed up to be a Mystery Reader yet?



How does a worm go into the soil? Watching it go!














Just a few of the amazing maps that the children drew, of their journey to school. Can you describe your journey to school? What do you see on the way? What kind of tree is at the front of the school?
