



Nursery Peek at the Week




Dip and Do


These are some ideas of things that you may like to do to support your child's learning at home.

- Can you make your own artistic masterpiece? What techniques will you use? Will you scrunch, rip or fold your paper?
 - Can you find different ways to make 4?
 - Can you make puppets to match your favourite 3 a day story?

New 3-a-day Stories for Ollie group children: These are stories that the children hear every day. These stories have been carefully chosen to help the children to develop a love of reading and to help them to develop early reading skills. These stories have key elements that support the children to retell them for example many of them use rhyme or repeated phrases.
