### Enquiry Question

#### EQ: What is an estuary, how are deltas formed and why do we need to protect them?

Estuaries are stretches where rivers approach the ocean. Freshwater from upstream and saltwater from rising tides mix here. Deltas are formed in the estuary, where the river deposits large amounts of sediment. Many estuaries are being seriously degraded by pollution. Pollution is probably the biggest threat to water quality in estuaries as well as flooding and rising sea levels due to climate change. Estuaries act as extraordinary habitats for unique marine life and birds. that are adapted to brackish water — a mix of both freshwater and saltwater. They are among the world's most productive ecosystems, but they are also incredibly vulnerable.
