Peek at the Week



Our Solar System

In Reception this week, the children have been expanding their knowledge of our Solar system. We have learnt about the properties of the different planets - discussing which ones we could stand on and which ones are gas giants - so we couldn't stand on those! The children have retained a lot of knowledge and have used that when completing their Star Writes, early morning writing and drawing planets using chalk while talking about what they know.

We have been learning about the properties of 3D shapes - cubes, cones, cylinders, cuboids, spheres, square based and triangular based pyramids and triangular prisms. The children have been handling the shapes and investigating their properties, talking about which ones have flat faces and which have curved surfaces. We have tested our knowledge using ramps to see which shapes roll and which slide. Then we pushed the 3D shapes into playdough to see what shapes we could see. We found out that the faces of 3D shapes are actually 2D shapes, that we already know. They have also practised their knowledge of doubles that we learnt about last week.

They have enjoyed playing with the class small worlds - with astronauts and aliens, moon rocks, alien spaceships and a rockets, making up fantastical stories about their journeys into space!
