## Enquiry Question of the week

How did trade get global?

A: Until the invention of steam ships in the 1700's most trade was local. After the industrial revolution of the late 1800's and the development of trains and planes meant that goods could be traded globally and faster. The development of the internet in 1992 meant that we can now buy goods from around the world at the touch of a button.
