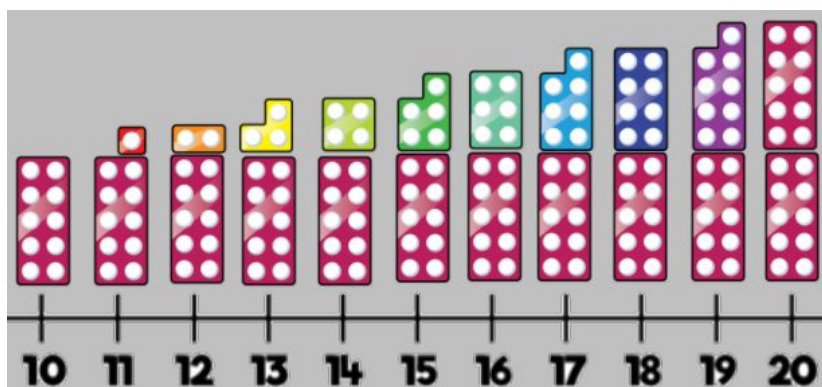


The Magic Roundabout - Bubbles

This week we went to Drawing Club. We watched an episode of 'The Magic Roundabout' called ' Bubbles'. The children had great fun designing their own bubble machines and drawing characters from the story. The children made bubble wands using wire, wool and sticks. They experimented by making the wands in different shapes to see if the bubbles still came out the same shape! They blew lots of bubbles outside.

The children practised their knowledge of odd and even numbers. They picked up a number of blocks and dropped them on the table. Then they checked to see if each block had a partner/pair, if they didn't and there was an odd one out, they worked out it was an odd number.

Our new learning in Maths was how to make numbers between 10 and 20 - teen numbers. We learnt that when numbers get past 10, the pattern of 1-9 happens all over again, but this time with a ten.
