Enquiry Question

What was the Industrial Revolution and how did this impact the lives of people and Britain?

A: The Industrial Revolution was like a giant leap forward in how people lived and worked. It was an incredible adventure that changed the world and set the stage for the way we live today! Machines and factories were invented to speed up the production of goods. New jobs were created for people to work the machines. People had to be retrained. Workers' conditions were often poor and there were many injuries. People moved away from the countryside to the city where the factories were for jobs.
