- Practise your quick recall of the Times Tables on TTRockstars at least 3 times a week.
- If your child is doing the Nesy Program or FlashAcademy, it is important they are logging on and completing the tasks at least 3 times a week.

Please Dip into these tasks. You do not have to do all 3 each week but of course you can if you want to! Tasks are set every Wednesday and due the following Wednesday.
