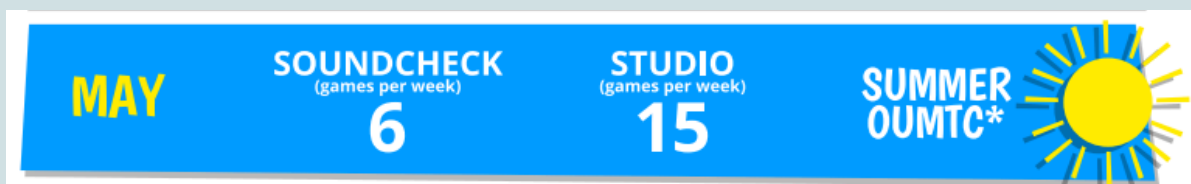


Peek into next week Year 4
