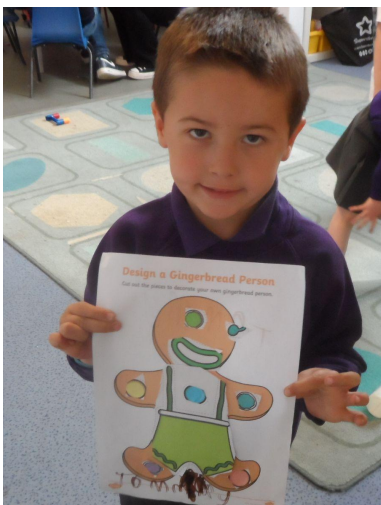


The Gingerbread Man

On Friday we all had a great time making our boats move across the pond using wind power!



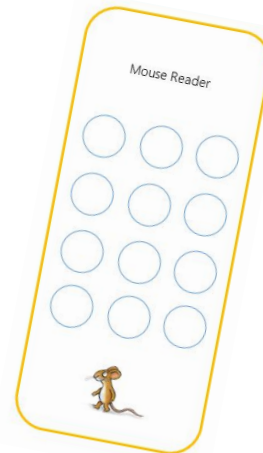
Dip and Do

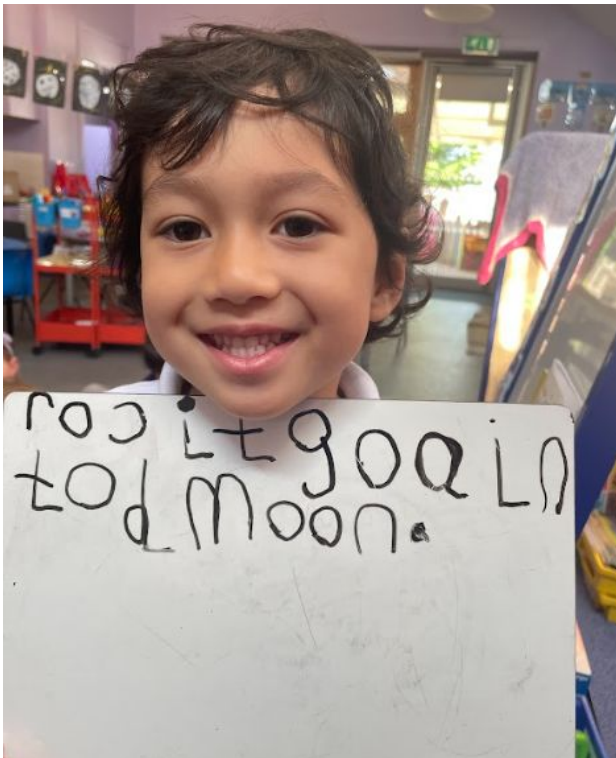

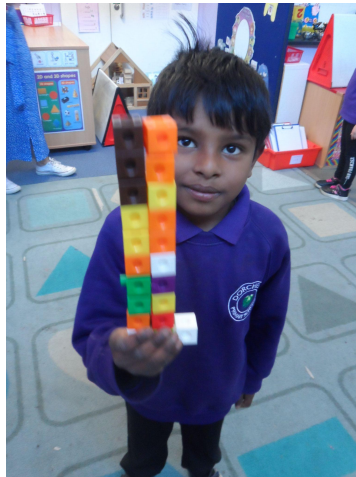
