Enquiry Question of the week

What were the main events of the Battle of Bosworth and how did this impact Britain?

A: The Battle of Bosworth in 1485 marked the end of the Wars of the Roses in England. Henry Tudor defeated King Richard III, becoming Henry VII. This battle led to the establishment of the Tudor dynasty, bringing stability to Britain and ending a period of civil war. Henry VII's reign paved the way for the Renaissance and significant changes in governance and economy.
