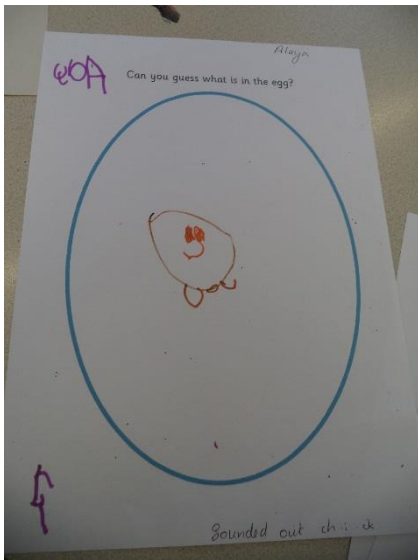

What have we been learning in Nursery?

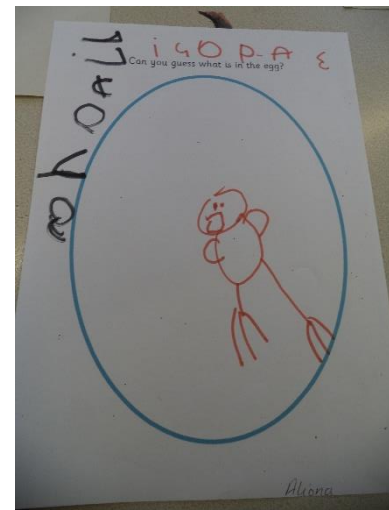
Please show your child these pictures and encourage them to talk about them.

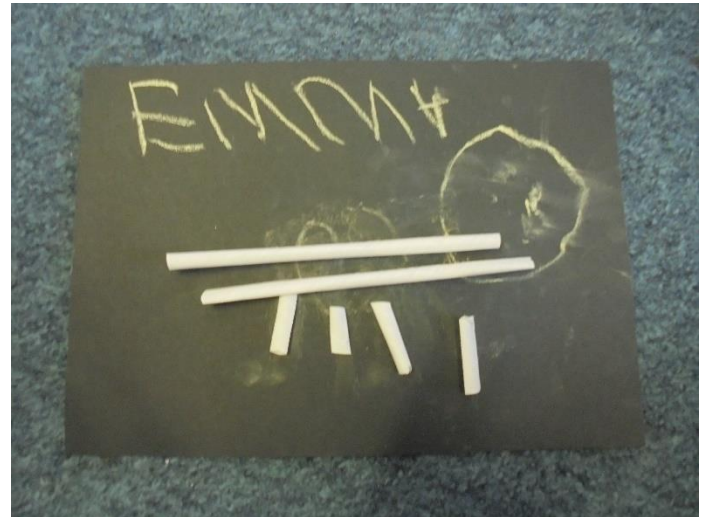
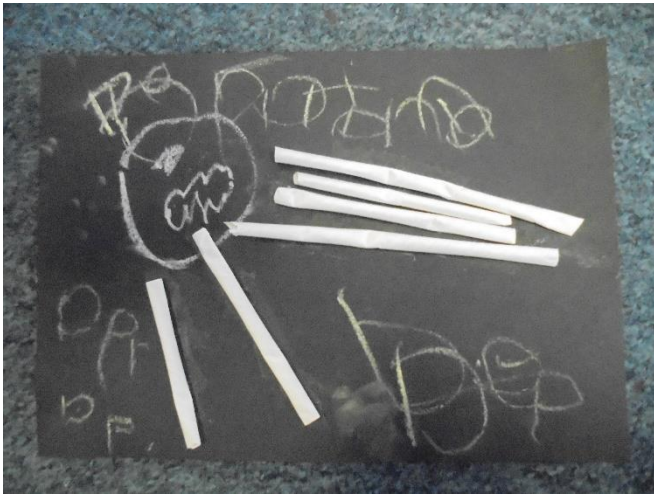






Look at these fantastic drawings to show what could be inside the egg.
