Year 6 Home Learning - Dip and Do

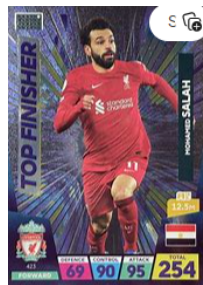
Summer 2, Week 2
